



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do you shoot on film or digital?

A: Totally digital.

Q: How long should we allow for our photo session?

A: For weddings with between 100 to 120 guests, it typically takes 45 minutes to an hour for family, group and other photographs after the ceremony. I recommend another 2 to 3 hours for location photography, depending on the number of locations you wish to visit, and the distance between locations.

Q: Do you offer an album registry?

A: Yes. Album registries allow your guests to give you a lasting and meaningful wedding gift by contributing toward the cost of your album and other products from our range.

Q: Can we have the digital negatives (high resolution photographs)?

A: Digital negatives are included in my higher value packages. If they are not included in your chosen package, you can purchase them as an add on, although you'll receive better value by including them as part of your initial package choice.

Q: How do I make reprints?

A. Reprints can be ordered through me up to 12 months after your wedding. If you have chosen a package which includes digital negatives, you can print your favourite photographs at any time, through any quality photo lab.

Q: Do you have a problem with guests or family members taking photos?

A: Guests and relatives are welcome to take their own photos after I have completely finished with a shot, as long as this doesn't affect the timing of your day. Just be aware that when several individuals are taking photographs at the same time, it's common for people to get distracted and look at different cameras.

Q: Do you travel?

A: Yes. We cover weddings across Melbourne, regional Victoria and interstate. Please contact me for travel rates. Destination weddings are always welcome, especially anywhere warm and exotic!
